INTRODUCTION:

The Ecosystem Maps of Lead-Safe Stakeholder Organizations in Detroit is a tool for visualizing the various stakeholder organizations involved in ending child lead poisoning in Detroit, their roles and activities within Detroit's lead-safe ecosystem, and their relations with each other. The Ecosystem Maps illustrate the network of organizations related to a specific commitment or involvement in the lead-safe ecosystem.

We define a lead-safe ecosystem as the system of actors who engage in — or are otherwise impacted by — activities related to reducing the risk of child lead poisoning and intervening when it does occur, as well as the conditions under which these actors must operate (including laws and policies, funding landscapes, housing stock conditions, etc.).

These maps are best read alongside the Directory of Lead-Safe Stakeholder Organizations in Detroit, which further details organizations' missions, activities, partnerships, and website and contact information.

The Ecosystem Maps of Lead-Safe Stakeholder Organizations in Detroit is a collaborative project between the City of Detroit Housing & Revitalization Department and Poverty Solutions at the University of Michigan. These maps provide a snapshot of Detroit's lead-safe ecosystem as of July 2023, and will be updated annually.
